How to choose a spiritual director...

Finding a spiritual director is a process that requires research, discernment, and prayer. You may have specific needs, preferences, and criteria that you are looking for in a spiritual guide, such as faith tradition, gender, location, education, and experience. You should consider talking to several spiritual directors before making your selection.

Here are a few questions to ask a prospective spiritual director:

- *What spiritual formation and training have you completed?*
- *What is your faith tradition and prayer practice?*
- *How long and where have you practiced spiritual direction?*
- *How would you describe your spiritual direction style?*
- *How do you continue your education and formation?*
- *What type of engagement agreement will we establish to clarify roles & responsibilities in our spiritual direction relationship?*
- *What fees do you charge?*
- *Where do you meet with your clients?*
- *Would you be willing to offer a free consultation session? (Most spiritual directors offer this.)*

In the process of selecting a spiritual director, be prepared to share your goals and any particular issues that you want to bring to spiritual direction. Knowing your intention for spiritual direction (e.g., enhancing your prayer practices, deepening your relationship to God) will help you find the best person to meet your needs.
